Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption returns include, but are not limited to, the following. taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number
